### **FROM YOUR BOARD: THE BOARD HELD A MEETING ON APRIL 9.**

- The proposed budget was discussed and approved for presentation for a vote of the membership.
- The revised Chapter Bylaws were reviewed and approved for presentation for a vote of the membership.
- Headquarters has agreed to scan our historic photos and documents. We will eventually be adding them to our website.
- Headquarters is willing to send out any “save the date” postcards that we might want.
- We considered other locations and lunch options for an occasional change from China Stix. There are some possibilities.
- We discussed having our holiday event at a different restaurant. (Update: Three Flames has been reserved!)
- We decided, based on member suggestions, to provide self-written name tags for people who would like to use them.
- Based on how well this meeting went, we agreed to change our board meeting days from just before membership meeting to the Wednesday week before. It will give us more time to cover the agenda and we won't feel rushed to get to the membership meeting.

## ***FROM MEMBERSHIP MEETINGS: THE LAST MEETING WAS HELD ON APRIL 30th***

- We had 59 members present, one new member and two members coming to the meeting for the first time.
- Our guest speaker was County of Santa Clara Benefits Director Rhonda Schmidt.
- The annual budget was approved by the membership.
- The revised Chapter Bylaws were approved by the membership.
- We currently have 1,834 members.
- A reminder that handouts from speakers are posted on our website with the newsletters. People who receive mailed newsletters do not get these handouts.
- We have open positions for secretary, speaker coordinator and Sargeant-at-arms.
- Headquarters provided us with a tall banner and a tabletop sign that we can use at our meetings and events.

### **BENEFITS CHANGES**

**O**ur County Benefits Director Rhonda Schmidt made her annual presentation to us about changes in our benefits. Although we receive this information by mail, her talk is always anticipated and well attended. She provided a handout of her slide presentation and a sheet of the Retiree Medicare B Premium Reimbursement Rates, July 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025. There are several big changes this year. The first is that we are changing to a calendar year plan. Mid-plan year rate changes by Kaiser and Valley Health Plan mean that some people may want to consider changing plans, and so the County is holding a special enrollment opportunity from May 1-31 for Kaiser and VHP enrollees. Also, VHP Classic Medicare Plan is now removed from eligible plans. Health Net PPO Medicare

COB Plan is added to eligible plans. On the positive side, several more representatives have been added to Benefits. 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### SCAMS

**D**ue to several requests, we are presenting yet another reminder about scams. It is very upsetting to think that someone is trying to trick you. But to fraudsters your feelings don't matter. They are just after your money, nothing personal. But to us it IS personal, and annoying, and infuriating, and hurtful, and embarrassing, and can be financially devastating.

The tactics haven't changed all that much, but the cleverness has kept up to date with the latest technologies like Artificial Intelligence and social media manipulation. The time-tested tactics are: something to scare you (like a deadline by which you must do something), something to appeal to your desire to obtain something, and something to appeal to your good nature to help someone.

We Board members have even received requests from our "treasurer" and our "president," asking to help obtain gift cards. Of course, we'd like to help out. But of course, it's odd that we hadn't discussed anything about it in our meetings. So, of course, we checked with each other. Yep, a scam. And they are very good at "spoofing" the person's email to look like it came from them, for example a susan dot net when it should be a susan dot com. Until recently, you could usually tell a fake sender. Now, you have to be extra careful.

Some recent ones to watch out for (taken from Bank of America online):

**Investment scams**, "They guaranteed a quick return." *There's no such thing. Always research investment opportunities before sharing your information.*

**Social media scams** "It seemed like such a great deal." *Deals on social media may offer fake goods or be too good to be true. Slow down, and do your research.*

**Tech support scams** "They needed access to 'fix' my computer." *Be cautious. Don't share security codes, passwords or account information. We'll never contact you to ask for those.*

In addition, lately there has been a rise in toll scams, social media-based investment scams, failed package delivery scams, and "a company you do business with is providing a refund for an overpayment" scams. Also, there are more sophisticated loneliness/romance scams.

Many companies appreciate being told you received a scam using their name. Bottom line: when you receive a request of any type, pause...know what to look for..and verify. If not sure, run it by someone you know and trust. Never reply or engage, even though you might want to tell them off. And, if it does happen, know that you are not alone...each one of us can be tricked in some way or another, especially during times of increased stress and upsetting news.

# Premium Rates

- Mid- Plan Year rate changes by Kaiser and Valley Health Plan (VHP) as part of the transition to a calendar year plan year:
  - Kaiser non-Medicare – 5.59%
  - Kaiser Senior Advantage – 15.53%
  - VHP for all plans – 15.75%

# Limited Special Enrollment Opportunity

- Available to retirees enrolled in Kaiser and VHP who will experience a change in cost.
- May 1 – 31, 2025:
  - Elect a lower cost plan
  - Remove dependents from coverage
  - Remove self and dependents from coverage

# Medicare Part B Reimbursement Changes

- VHP Classic Medicare Plan is removed from eligible plans
- Health Net PPO Medicare COB Plan is added to eligible plans

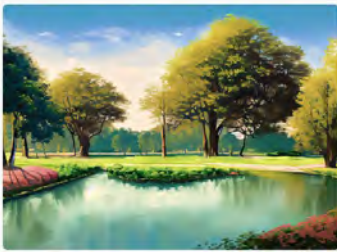

  - July, Aug., Sept., is paid at the end of October
  - Oct., Nov., Dec. is paid at the end of January
- Retirees can arrange for direct deposit of their quarterly Medicare reimbursement into a banking account of their choice by contacting the Employee Benefits Department at (408) 970-2600.
- Premium rate contributions and Medicare B reimbursement amounts are subject to change each calendar year. Not all medical plans are eligible for reimbursement.
- Retirees who retired on or before December 5, 1983 receive the actual amount paid for Medicare B.
